

Activity ideas – living stones and Jesus the cornerstone

- Can you build a tower of Jenga, Lego or Duplo bricks (or anything else!) and pray for people in our church family as you place each on the pile? You could pray for people in your group – Bubbles, Splash, Lightsharers or Youth, or anyone else you know! Remember that Jesus is the most important brick, holding us all together and keeping us strong.
- Can you find some stones to paint, and put them around the area you live to encourage people with happy messages? Acrylic paint is best but you could also use up bits of paint you might have in the house or garage.
- Here's the recipe for rock cakes – with sultanas or chocolate chips:

200g self raising flour
1 tsp mixed spice
¼ tsp salt
1 tsp ginger
75g butter or margarine
75g caster sugar
100g sultanas
1 beaten egg
2 tblsp milk
Glaze cherries

Heat the oven to 180C. Mix the dry ingredients and rub in the butter until the mixture looks like breadcrumbs. Stir in the sugar, then the sultanas and finally the egg and milk. Form into 10 balls, top each with a halved glaze cherry and place on a greased baking tray. Bake for 15-20 minutes. Enjoy warm from the oven!
